Welcome Service

Mentor System	One local student is assigned to an exchange student to help with airport pick-up, orientation and settling in.
Welcome event / Orientation week	Fall: September 14, 2017 / Spring: February 26, 2018
Airport pickup	Yes, but fees caused should be paid by the exchange student. Fee for airport pick-up service is around NT\$1200 per person. (Fall Only)
(Intensive) language courses offered during the semester (Fee-Paying Courses)	Yes. But the Chinese Courses in our Chinese Language Center (CLC) are fee-paying courses. Other useful information / Comments

Visa procedures	Students should handle their visa application in their home countries prior to entry to Taiwan. Please apply for a visitor (1 semester study)/resident visas (1 year study) at the nearest Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) or the embassy.
Health Check Forms for Visas	<p>1-year exchange students should complete the Health Report (FORM B) in their home country prior to apply a residence visa.</p> <p>1-semester exchange students are required to complete the Health Report (FORM C), but the X-ray check is suggested to do after entry to Taiwan.</p> <p>**All of foreigner students are required to do a X-Ray check after they enter to Taiwan.</p>
Special Academic Programs	<p>The Chinese courses of Chinese Language Center have no credit (0 credit) and may cause extra fees for students.</p> <p>Bachelor students are not allowed to attend the higher level courses (ie. Master/PhD Programs). Master/PhD students can take a lower courses, yet is unable to get an equivalence credits for a graduated or post-graduated studies.</p> <p>*ISTM courses now is all fee-paying courses, reciprocal students should get permission to take the courses from the ISTM courses and probably caused extra fees in its programs.</p>
