

- 8. Broad range of courses in International Business (IB); majors in '1. Marketing & Strategy', '2. Finance & Accounting' and '3. Human Resource Management & Organization'
- **9.** Taught 100% in English (exchange students can attend business courses in German in other study programmes of ESB Business School if required)
- **10.** International dimension in the composition of the student body (50% international students plus ~70 IB exchange students per year from more than 40 partner universities)
- **11.** Three levels of careful tutoring for exchange students within the IB study programme: Head of Undergraduate Partnerships, Incoming Coordinator, Student Buddies
- **12.** Small seminar-like groups, workshops, case studies, guest lectures by professionals, visits to leading international companies







Location of Reutlingen

- 13. Located in one of the most scenically attractive areas of Germany (the 'Swabian Jura') close to the Neckar valley, some 20 miles south of Stuttgart
- 14. Especially attractive for overseas' students: located in the center of Europe $(4 \frac{1}{2})$ hours by train to Paris, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ hours by plane to London, 7 hours by train to Prague, 6 ¹/₂ hours by car to the Mediterranean)
- The region is home to the world or European headquarters of many prominent 15. companies including Hugo Boss, Daimler, Porsche, Bosch, Celesio, Hewlett-Packard, IBM
