Visa procedures	Students should handle their visa applications in their home countries prior to entry to Taiwan. Please apply a vistor visa (1 semester study)/a resident visa (1 year study) at the nearest Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) or embassies.
Health Check Forms for Visas	1-year exchange students should complete the Health Report (FORM B) in their home country prior to apply a residence visa. 1-semester exchange students are required to complete the Health Report (FORM C), but the X-ray check is suggested to do after entry to Taiwan. *All of foreigner students are required to do a X-Ray check after they enter to Taiwan.
Special Academic Programs	The intensive courses of Chinese Language Center (CLC) are non-fee-waving programs and no credits (0 credit). CLC's courses may cause extra fees for exchange students. Some special programs for Vietnam Partnership Universities and due-drgree/academic programs under the International School of Technology and Management (ISTM) are NOT available for exchange students.
