-Please make your \$500 deposit at the cashier's office (same building as the registrar) or online and bring print out of your receipt with the attached completed enrollment form to Dr. Boitano so that he can sign off on it. There are only 10 spots available and the first 10 students to make the deposit with an enrollment form signed by the instructor will be automatically accepted. Dr. Boitano's office is located in 121 DeMille Hall in the Dept. of World Languages & Cultures (DeMille Hall 121). His email is jboitano@chapman.edu. His weekly office hours are TuTh 4-5:30PM & Fri 10AM-12PM & by appointment.

-Price Range: \$2,924-\$3,216* Classes offered: FREN 101, 102, 201, 345 & 399 (*French 101 requires no previous knowledge of French and is open to all students. Only 1 class may be taken. FREN 201 and FREN 345 fulfill the language requirement and count towards the French major, minor and Inter/Multidisciplinary GE Cluster. The prerequisite class for FREN 201 is FREN 102 and for FREN 345, it is FREN 201. The prerequisite class for FREN 102 is FREN 101*).

-Arrival Date in Nice, France: Sunday, June 10, 2018. Last day of classes: 1PM, Friday, June 29, 2018 (You can leave Nice on Saturday, June 30, 2018 as housing is provided for the evening of June 29, or you can leave on Friday, June 29 after 1PM when class finishes)

Price includes the following:

- 1) Lodging, Daily Breakfasts & Dinners with homestay family, Arrival Lunch on Monday 6/11 and Departure Dinner on Thursday 6/28.
- 2) French Language class at appropriate level at local language school (all levels will be offered: FR 101, 102, 201, 345 & 399: classes meet Tuesday-Friday: Class will exceptionally be held at France Langue School on the first Monday (6/11/2018).
- 3) Local tours (Monaco, The Artistic Village of St. Paul de Vence, the Medieval Village of Èze, French cooking class, and historical sites in Nice, ...etc.)
- 4) Ground transportation from airport, train station or hotel in Nice to host family on arrival day and from host family to train station or airport on departure day.
- 5) Local bus/tram pass is provided; it provides students with unlimited use of buses and trams in the local area.

*Round-trip airfare from USA to France and ground transportation in the USA are **not included**. Students must complete and be eligible for a tuition waiver form to avoid being charged tuition in addition to the course fee. The course fee (\$2,924-\$3,216*) cannot be waived: only the tuition may be waived for eligible students. In general, if you are full-time in the fall and in the spring, you will be eligible for a one-time tuition waiver of a travel course. Students must fill out and return the tuition waiver form to the Business Office (same location as the registrar-Bhathal Student Services Center, 150 W. Syacamore, tel. 714-997-6627) at the time of the deposit. First-generation college students can apply for a scholarship to sponsor their travel seminar with Chapman's Promising Futures program/Scholarship Opportunities for Short-Term Abroad. —initial— 1. By signing this document, I authorize Chapman University to immediately enroll/register me in **FREN 101,102,201,345,399: French Travel Course** which has a total cost range of **\$2,924.00-\$3,216.00** and may incur expenses such as lodging, some meals, etc., not to exceed **\$3,216.00**, and to make payments on my behalf for those expenditures.

—initial— 2. I understand that I must make a **\$500 deposit** to the University Cashier in Bhathal Student Services or through the Student ePay System before **4PM, Tues, March 27, 2018**. I further understand that until my deposit receipt, Valid Passport or Passport paperwork and this completed Enrollment form are all received by the Center for Global Education before **4PM, Tues, March 27, 2018**, I will not be enrolled in this course and my position in this course has not been secured.

—initial— 3a. I understand that by submitting this completed document, a Valid Passport or Passport paperwork, and proof of Deposit to Center for Global Education, I will be enrolled in the above referenced course and my deposit **will not be refundable** unless one of the following occurs:

- i. I fail to receive preliminary clearance from the Dean of Students office
- ii. The course is cancelled

—initial— 3b. I further understand that my deposit will not be refunded for any other reason; including, but not limited to, injury or illness.

—initial— 4. In addition to losing my deposit, I will also be responsible for the **TOTAL COST OF THE COURSE and ALL OTHER EXPENSES incurred on my behalf** if any of the following occur:

- i. I withdraw from the course **any time after enrollment**; or
- ii. I become unable to participate due to injury or illness at **any time after enrollment**; or
- iii. I become ineligible to participate **after the preliminary clearance** has been provided by the Dean of Students office

—initial— 5a. Given these consequences of nonrefundable deposit and requirements to pay the full Travel Course expenses as indicated in number 4 above, the university strongly recommends students consider the purchase of trip cancellation insurance, for which they may be eligible for.

—initial— 5b. I understand that I may have an 'option' to purchase trip cancellation insurance. Quotes may be obtained at <http://edu.insuremytrip.com/chapman/>. Coverage is limited to trips having a maximum trip length of 45 days and maximum expense of \$10,000. This insurance is a personal choice and not required for a Chapman University Travel Course.

—initial— 6. Tuition fees are separate from the Travel Course fees listed in Condition one. Prior to departure, **the Office of Student Business Services may bill me for tuition for these credits.** Rules and regulations governing Travel Course tuition fees, as well as Travel Course Tuition Waivers, can be found at <http://www.chapman.edu/international-studies/center-for-global-education>

—initial— 7. I understand that the University will only accept a credit card payment for the initial deposit indicated in number 2 above, and all other charges will be billed to my student account and will not be eligible for payment by credit card. **Final Payment** to the University Cashier is due before **4 PM, Mon., May 14, 2018.**

—initial— 8. I understand that my student conduct and Office of Student Business Service records will be reviewed up to the time of departure and my participation is dependent upon receiving a clearance from both offices. If the clearance is revoked by the Dean of Students' office based on any incident that occurs after **Tues., April 10, 2018** I will still be financially responsible for the total cost of the Travel Course and all other expenses incurred on my behalf.

—initial— 9. I understand that I am enrolling in this class for a grade. If I wish to audit, I am responsible for obtaining the approval of the Faculty, Travel Course & Internship Manager and the Registrar's Office.

—initial— 10. If receiving credit, I understand that the CGE Office will enroll me in this Travel Course through the Office of the Registrar. When the Travel Course occurs during Interterm or Spring Break, I will receive my grades at the end of May. If the Travel Course occurs during the Summer Session, I will receive my grade at the end of August in compliance with Summer Session 4 term guidelines.

—initial— 11. I understand that the cost for Tuition credit is not included in the Travel Course program fees. If I wish to be considered for a one-time Tuition Waiver, I will complete and submit a Tuition Waiver form to the Business Office in order that they may determine my eligibility status.

—initial— 12. I understand that round trip airfare may or may NOT be included in the cost of the Travel Course program and that itinerary details are subject to change at any point.

—initial— 13. I understand that if I am required to be sent home from the trip due to violations of the Conduct Code or any other unforeseen occurrence such as Illness, or Natural Disaster, I will be responsible for any additional costs for my care or return home.
