Hotel Accommodations for Saturday night, January 6 and Friday night, January 12—Monday morning, January 15, 2018:

- We will be staying at this hotel on Saturday night, January 6, 2018 then checking out and moving to St. Jude Community Center on Sunday, January 7, 2018.
- Check-out time is **12:00 p.m.** On Sunday, January 7, we will have a class meeting in the hotel from 9:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m., so you should be packed and ready to check-out beforehand or immediately after.
  - Light continental breakfast items will be available during the meeting.

- Rooms are divided by gender, dormitory style, and each has bunks. <u>You must bring your own toiletries,</u> <u>bedding, sheets, pillows, blankets, and/or sleeping bag.</u> The building has air-conditioning and heating. Electrical outlets are limited.
- **Curfew** Sunday through Friday 1:00am. The on-site guard leaves at 1:00am; after this point you may not have access back into the building.
- **Quiet time** 10PM 6AM; during this time, all voices must be kept to a whisper; phone calls must be taken outside and any radio/televisions must be turned off.
- **Restrooms/ Showers** There are separate male and female restrooms and showers. Showers are in a common area within the bathrooms, with dividers/curtains around each shower.
- Lockers there are <u>no lockers</u> available for use; please consider this ahead of time when determining what to bring.
- **Meals** are provided daily by a staff member of the St. Jude Community Center.
  - Breakfast is served between the hours of 6:00am and 7:00am. During this timeframe, food will also be available to pack for lunch. You must be finished eating breakfast and packing your lunch by 7:00am.
  - o Dinner is served around 6:00pm.
- **Snacks** You are encouraged to bring your own snack foods into the facility but they must remain in the dining area DO NOT bring them back to your sleeping area.
- Internet Free wireless internet access is available within the building.
